Angelo Lambs Steady,

Feeder Cattle Weak

SAN ANGELO -(USDA)- Feeder lambs sold steady Tuesday, slaughter lambs firm, slaughter ewes weak to \$2 lower, nannies steady, kids firm. Receipts totaled 7725 head.

Feeder steers and heifers were weak to \$1 lower Thursday, slaughter cows and bulls steady, stock cows and pairs steady. Receipts totaled 1362 head.
